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HOLY CITY AND UNHOLY PRACTICES

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"Every gun that is made, every warship launched, every rocket fired, signifies, in the final sense, a theft from those who hunger and are not fed, those who are cold and are not clothed. The world in arms is not spending money alone. It is spending the sweat of its labourers, the genius of its scientists, the hopes of its children...This is not a way of life at all, in any true sense. Under the cloud of threatening war, it is humanity hanging from a cross of iron". A Cross-of Iron Dwight D. Eisenhower

Definitely it is not a way of life at all. It is Bethlehem humanity hanging from the New Berlin Wall of Bethlehem. Few days ago, we woke up on a military seizure order issued by the Israeli occupation forces on Feb 16, 2003, which States that 14 dunams (3.5 acres) are being taken for three years. According to Palestinian sources, such a policy clearly shows that there is a plan to strangulate the city and confiscate its northern entrance and annexing it to Israel. Furthermore, the Israeli authority aims to separate Rachel Tomb area from the rest of Bethlehem.

According to Bethlehem Mayor Hanna Nasser 4000 dunams (1,000) acres will be cut off from the rest of Bethlehem by security Wall.

3000 Palestinians' are living under a nightmare of confiscating land, destroying homes and businesses. Insecurity, insafety, vulgarity and poignancy are the remarks of this ambiguous cloudy situation we live under. An eight- meter wall will be erected to separate families from each other, isolate pieces of land here and there and create unhealthy atmosphere in terms of resuming regular life specially after the 30 months of siege to the city of Bethlehem, frequent military incursions coupled with lengthy days of curfew.

Jamal became agitated by such equivocal measures by saying that this military order will deprive Bethlehem from very vital breathing outlet and choke one of city's main healthy breathing lung. Another citizen mentioned that Walls all over the world have been dismantled?? Why do we need such uncivilized Walls to be built in the city of peace?

Yes, Israeli Authority will confiscate 25% of Bethlehem initial Town planning. The main North entrance of Bethlehem has been stifled by the new recent methods. Tourism has been given a harsh blow... Palestinian Moslems can't bury their dead in the cemetery surrounding Rachel's Tomb. The Armenian Church, and the Islamic Waqf have losst lots of property in addition to people's private property. Dunums of agricultural land has been expropriated...
